Comes with spray skirts and two quick blade paddles. For sale by Charlotte & Alastair. It's lightweight, carbon fibre. \$4500. Layla and Huriana used it at Kaiteriteri. 8m long.</p>	

	<p>Black and white. Need to look at our fleet and see if this would be beneficial?</p> <p>What is the benefit for the club? Advantage is that it's lighter. In the water it would be more tippy. Maintenance on a lighter waka will be higher cost as not as sturdy. Gives us something a bit more competitive. Would be dipping into fund. Were advised that it would be better to have a more sturdy option. The races our club is doing are regional, not national, therefore not necessarily a need for a higher spec. Storage – there isn't enough room and they are going to get marked. The yellow one was bought by \$2000. Te Wairua bought three years ago, worth \$5000. Jeff thinks it's a really good idea because of the weight of the existing waka that we have. Although there is a trolley that could be used. The existing waka aren't being used all at the same time currently, so doesn't seem like there is a need for it. Park it for tonight and reconsider as part of the Strategic Meeting. Jeff will let them know we're still in discussion.</p>
