Picton Rowing Club Long Distance Paddle – Sunday 16th October 2022. 9am start

Picton Rowing extends an invitation to all interested rowers and supporters to participate in a long distance paddle on Sunday 16th October 2022. Due to the recent flooding and potential difficulty with road access, we have taken the decision to run the event this year from the Picton foreshore to the Snout and back. A distance of 12km return. The event is limited to fours, quads, eights and octuples. There will also be a separate category for coastal quads and waka ama's. The course may be shortened in the event of bad weather.

Entry fees are \$20 per person, \$10 for juniors (coxwains free) to cover the staging of the event and includes the barbecue and beverages at the prize giving.

Race information and entry forms are enclosed. As this will be a handicapped start, please indicate roughly how long you think your crews will take to complete the 12km course on the entry form. Crews will be set off at intervals with slowest crews first.

All cars will need to park in the main town car park and walk over the bridge to PRC or park in the grass area opposite the St Johns First Aid building , at the marina as directed.


Barbecue and Prize giving
