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<b>reports</b>	Need to reiterate to steerers the need for VHF radios when going long distance or away from shore.		
<b>Gear and Maintenance</b>	<p><b>-Ana Hau rudder:</b> Repairs have been done on Ana Hau. The rudder has a split in the shaft and can't be repaired. It needs to be replaced.</p> <p>Pete proposed that we buy a new rudder for Ana Hau, Damian 2<sup>nd</sup></p> <p><b>-Multi tools:</b> Need to make sure that the new multi tools are in the OC2 safety boxes</p> <p><b>-OC2 Hull:</b> Splits in the OC2 hull is likely to have come from being tied down too tight in transport says Pete Barratt.</p> <p><b>- Kiato covers:</b> We had quotes for the kiato covers We have had quotes for new covers Kiato covers \$793 for 8 covers Ama covers \$595 for 2 ama covers KT proposed that we purchase 6 new kiato covers and 2 new ama covers up to the value of \$1400. 2<sup>nd</sup> Damian.</p> <p><b>-Spray Skirts:</b> We have had a quote for spray skirts. We would like the new super duper ones with velcro and rubber cockpit entries. There was a quote for \$1575 Damian to email for clarification Spray skirts for Mangopare (1990) are very flimsy.</p> <p><b>-New OC2:</b> the steering cable snapped when Chris and Bryn were paddling. Chris got a split ring to repair it. Pete to check it.</p>	<p>Jan to send Paul Wilford's details to Zoe.</p> <p>Zoe to contact Moana Nui re rudder.</p> <p>Damian to organise the new kiato and ama covers</p> <p>Damian to email for clarification on composition of spray skirts.</p>	
<b>Membership</b>	We have 2 new paid up members, Michelle Robinson but there is no form in yet for her, & Cass. Other new paddlers are Suzanne we have no details for, Sue Martin, not sure if she has paid, and Debbie Dalziel		
<b>Portage 20<sup>th</sup> May</b>	<p>3 waka have been booked, steerers being Karen Clark, Penny Molnar and Greg Buck. Penny and Greg have put in a request to the committee to paddle an OC12 and have emailed Andrea to see if that is OK as far as the race is concerned.</p> <p>It was suggested (in Committee) that they only do the first 10km as they have some not very experienced paddlers in the crew and then they could take it easy on the 10km home. The committee suggested that they have a go at steering a 12 before the race as it is very different than an OC6.</p>

<b>Racing</b>	Gina and Rongomai were talking with KT about getting some crews together to give paddlers a goal to work towards in different age categories.		
<b>OC2 transport</b>	We transport the waka about 7 times per year. How can we make it easier and safer for the waka as there has been damage. Zoe proposed that we buy some normal tie down straps specifically for the OC2s (to a maximum value of \$100) so they are not tied in with the main waka straps until we can come up with a more permanent solution. Jan 2 <sup>nd</sup> .	<p>Damian to purchase.</p> <p>Jan to give Damian Mark Creswell's contact details for cradles.</p>	

<b>Marae-MOCC combining forces</b>	Zoe was asked by Huriana and Leila about membership rates for Maitahi and what the rules were for using our equipment if they were club members. What do they need to do to get signed off, how do they get signed off? The process of getting signed off with the marae for steering is done by Hayden. It seems similar to ours so Pete and Hayden can liaise if steerers want to cross over clubs. The marae has some social/non competitive crews, it would be great to get a little more interclub stuff going. Amalgamation of the 2 clubs isn't a possibility because of waka ownership. Fees would need to be paid to both clubs for paddlers wishing to paddle with both clubs. Marae fees are \$80/year October to September.		
<b>V1 OC1</b>	Jan suggested that the next addition to the fleet could be a V1 or an OC1. An OC1 might be more versatile as it can be used ruddered or rudderless. Fibre glass would be more robust as carbon fibre is quite fragile and club gear seems to get a hammering. It would increase the versatility for numbers in social paddling. Signing off would have to be thought out.	Jan to get prices	
<b>Water Sports Facility</b>	The council has bought Totally Boating building and yard.	Kilmeny to chat with Gary to find out if the facility is any closer than just talk.	
<b>Website</b>	Char proposed that we go ahead with the website proposal put in by Avoca Web Design and as discussed with the website sub committee. Jan will build the site for free. Hosting will provided at the Not for Profit rate of \$214.50/yr 2 <sup>nd</sup> by everyone	Char to get 2 quotes	
<b>President</b>	Zoe indicated she will not be standing for re-election as president in August.	Jan to put into Newsletter to get people thinking.
